<u>Government gives major thrust for developing airports in</u> <u>Uttar Pradesh</u>

The government is working to give a big push to operationalize numerous airports in Uttar Pradesh. Rs 400 crore will be provided by the Centre for developing airports in Agra, Allahabad, Kanpur and Bareilly.

The assistance would be provided by the government within a period of one and a half months. An airport in Kushinagar will also be developed, for which the state government had provided Rs 200 crore and the work is being executed by RITES and would be complete with a year.

This will strengthen internal air connectivity within the state of Uttar Pradesh, enhance infrastructure and improve business environment thereby providing a push to economic development within the state.
